Public Notifiacation

According to Department of Surface Transport's regional office in Lingmithang, Mongar, the Nganglam-Gyelpoizhing primary national highway will remain closed to traffic until further notice due to the collapse of Kuri-Gongri bailey bridge. In this regard, the Gewog Administration, Silambi under Mongar Dzongkhag would like to notify the general public that the alternative road connecting Mongar-Nganglam, from Silambi GC to Gongdue GC shall be monitored strictly for heavy load carrying vehicles. This is mainly because to prevent the bridges under Silambi and Gongdue Gewog from the same unfortunate incidence. The bridges at Hapola and Gangchetpo, Silambi Gewog have the capacity of 15metricton only and no vehicles carrying more than that capacity shall be permitted to cross.

Therefore, the commuters are reminded to note this information and plan the travel accordingly. In case, if anyone is found neglecting this information and travelling, the concern shall be accounted for violation and risks involved.
