## **Dzongkhag Administration**

#### **Budget Overview**

For the Financial Year 2024-2025, Mongar Dzongkhag received a total budget of Nu. 981.350 million; the details shown in the table below. The budget was endorsed by the 6<sup>th</sup> Dzongkhag Tshogdu. The Dzongkhag prioritized economic revival and the promotion of its tourism industry. Efforts were directed towards enhancing local livelihoods, strengthening key economic sectors (Agriculture, Livestock Tourism, etc), and setting the Dzongkhag as a vibrant hub for cultural and eco-tourism. These initiatives aimed to accelerate post-pandemic recovery while preserving the region's heritage and natural beauty.

By the end of the Financial Year, the Dzongkhag achieved an overall budget utilization rate of 94%, reflecting effective financial planning and prudent resource management. Expenditures were closely monitored to ensure transparency and accountability, with regular reporting to relevant oversight bodies. # 1. Agriculture Sector

## **Major Activities**

**Activity 1:** Chain Link Fencing

Funding source: GoI/PTA

Chain-link fencing is one of the priority activities of the current Government. Mongar Dzongkhag was allocated with Nu. 29.25 m through GoI/PTA funding support to carry out the aforementioned activity, with Kengkhar and Shermuhung Gewogs identified as project sites for the first phase. The details of the work are as follows:

Activity 2: Supply of Fresh Vegetables and Fruits for Gyelsuung, Gyelpozhing

Since August 29, 2024, the Gyalsung Academy in Gyelposhing has been receiving fresh local vegetables and fruits from farmers across Mongar, including Drepong, Chali, Tahskaling, Saling, and Tshamang Gewogs. The supply, occurring twice a week (Monday and Thursday), includes 22 types of vegetables (including mushrooms) and 3 types of fruits. A total of 35.878MT of vegetables and fruits has been supplied to Gyelsuung academia, generating the income of Nu. 1.650 million so far.

Activity 3: Renovation of Market Shed at Mongar Town

Under the CARLEP/IFAD funding, major maintenance and refurbishment efforts focused on the top two floors to enhance functionality and usability. The infrastructure is structured to optimize the marketing and distribution of agricultural produce. The top floor is designated for locally grown vegetables, while the second floor accommodates imported vegetables and grains. The ground floor is reserved for meat



shops. This facility is expected to significantly benefit and serve the nearby Gewogs of Mongar, Drepong, Chali, and Tshakaling, improving market access and strengthening local agricultural value chains.

**Activity 1:** Promotion of Winter Fodder Hydroponics

**Funding source: CARLEP** 

**Type of funding:** Annual Grant **Total Budget:** Nu. 0.960 m

Hydroponic fodder cultivation is an emerging smart solution to address green fodder shortages during the lean winter season. This method requires less land and labor, producing fresh, nutritious fodder in just 12–15 days, with plants reaching about 30 cm in height. Though the initial investment is high, government support has made the technology affordable for farmers. In winter, when milk production often declines due to fodder scarcity, hydroponic fodder serves as an excellent supplement, mixed with hay and crop residues to maintain animal nutrition. To promote this innovation, Dzongkhag has established 18 hydroponic nurseries in dairy potential areas, ensuring year-round feed availability and supporting better milk yields.

**Activity 2:** Fodder Slips Propagation



Fodder grass slips propagation has been a part of an animal nutrition development program aimed at enhancing the forage availability for the dairy animals. During the financial year 2024-25, the livestock sector had supplied 1,58,032 nos. of Pakchung grass slips cuttings (three nodes) covering 150.032 acres of uncultivated agriculture and marginal lands. Considering the 100% germination rate of the stem cuttings, it would produce around 229. 15 MT of Dry Matter yields per year. Apart from providing nutrition, grass slip propagations have helped farmers to utilize the fallow and marginal lands effectively. The plantations are predominantly seen along the newly constructed farm roads as the fibrous root system of the grass slips binds soil and prevents soil erosion. The fresh and green grass slips serve as the raw materials for making the silage to conserve the fodder for subsequent use in lean seasons.

The Dzongkhag Livestock Sector organized a dairy show and exhibition in Chaskhar Gewog on 21st June 2025. The program was attended by around 150 dairy HHs along with more than 200 numbers of hybrid cattle. The objectives of the show were to showcase some of the best dairy breeds, to create a platform for learning and knowledge exchange among dairy farmers, and to improve farm productivity, along with creating new partnerships and opportunities.

The participants were also advocated about earthquake, forest fire, flood, and windstorm disasters. The participants were confident and able to use the fire extinguisher equipment and LPG gas.

Wengkhar Nagtshang, a historic structure, was originally constructed around 1646 by Umzee Damchoe Rabgay and Kudrung Pelkar Choephel under the command of Chogyal Minjur Tempa. This sacred site is also revered as the birthplace of Zhabdrung Jigme Drakpa, and it houses the precious relics of this



esteemed figure, preserving a profound spiritual and historical legacy. The restoration of Wengkhar Nagtshang was undertaken as a conservation initiative to preserve its sacred essence and architectural integrity.

Aja Ney is one of the sacred and most popular pilgrimage sites in Eastern Bhutan that people regularly visit. People often face accommodation challenges while visiting Aja Ney; hence, the Dzongkhag Administration initiated the construction of eco-lodge, guest house, kitchen, and the enhancement of the trail. The amenities are developed at 3 sites: Nimathang (Aja), Ugyen Draphu, and Shelridzong. The fund was supported by the Department of Tourism, Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Employment through the GEF Eco-tourism project 'Mainstreaming biodiversity conservation into tourism sector in Bhutan'.

Activity 2: Mongar Eco-trail enhancement (Phase II)

The Dzongkhag Administration carried out the enhancement of eco-trail from Jaiphu Pam to Pongchula which is the continuation of the first phase eco-trail that stretches from Phurjurlaptsa to Jaiphu Pam. The trail stretches around 5km in total. The structures such as canopies, 2-unit toilet, swings and wooden bences are developed to enhance the experience of visitors. A similar trail enhancement and structures are also developed for Jarjab trail. It was supported by the Department of Tourism, Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Employment through the GEF Eco-tourism project 'Mainstreaming biodiversity conservation into tourism sector in Bhutan'.

Funded at Nu. 8.932 million, comprising an 8-unit classroom block with an administrative section. Originally, it was planned for completion in 2022. However, the project extended over five years due to the COVID-19 pandemic and contractor negligence. From 2025 onward, the facility has been fully utilized for senior classes (VII–X), the ADM Assistant's office, and a library, significantly enhancing the learning environment for two Gewogs under Werringla Dungkhag.

The construction of ECCD centres at Narang, Yadi, Dremtse, Udaric, and Silambi, funded by the World Bank with a total allocation of Nu. 14.57 million has been completed. The other two ECCD centers at Bagging and Waichur are under construction with the funding support from the World Bank, amounting to Nu. 5.00 m. These facilities provide young children in the community with a safe, nurturing, and stimulating learning environment, laying a strong foundation for early childhood development. The centres enhance school readiness by improving early literacy, numeracy, and social skills, fostering community engagement in child development and education.

In order to strive for excellence in leadership, RIGSS, in collaboration with the Dzongkhag Administration, Mongar, conducted two cohorts of RIGSS Mobile Leadership Training at Kidheykhar HSS from 28th August to 3rd September 2024. A total of 408 participants (202 and 206 respectively in each batch) from diverse sub-agencies within the Dzongkhag, including the Dzongkhag Administration, Gewogs, schools, regional offices, and corporations, attended the training. During the 3-day session, the RIGSS Team, led by the RIGSS Director, Dasho Chewang Rinzin, trained public servants under the Dzongkhag on essential leadership skills that contribute to professional excellence, covering diverse topics to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of public service delivery.

Hon'ble Sowai Lyonpo officially initiated the pilot rollout of the Annual Household-Health Surveillance (AHS) in Yakgang on 5th May, 2025. In light of the high prevalence of tobacco use, alcohol consumption, and doma (areca nut) chewing in Bhutan, AHS aims to be a sustainable, community-driven approach to disease prevention, health promotion, and improved public health outcomes. Mongar and Wangdue Phodrang are piloting 100% population coverage, while other Dzongkhags will begin with at least 10% scaling up to nationwide implementation next year.

In line with the government's initiative to promote private sector development and improve service delivery efficiency, the waste collection service in the towns (Mongar, Gyelpozhing, and Lingmethang) has been outsourced to WeCare Company, Mongar, at a negotiated rate of Nu. 150,000 per month for a period of one year, starting from 1st March 2025. The roles and responsibilities for waste management have been clearly defined in the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to ensure accountability and effective implementation. Engaging a private party in waste management offers several advantages, including the promotion of waste segregation at source, enhanced recycling practices, and the encouragement of reuse initiatives, thereby contributing to environmental sustainability. In addition to waste collection, the operation and management of the town's incinerator have also been outsourced to WeCare Company, ensuring an integrated and streamlined waste disposal process. Also, the Waste segregation at source, primarily into wet (kitchen waste) and dry categories, was initiated to promote responsible waste management and environmental sustainability.

## **Completed Activities**

## 1. Laying of GSB from Dzongkhag Road to Gangmung Chiwog in Shermuhung Gewog





The Granular Sub-Base (GSB) laying project from Sherimuhung Dzongkhag Road to Gangmung Chiwog Farm Road was successfully completed by M/s Thongja Construction, Mongar, for a contract value of *Nu. 9,187,515.00*, funded by the Government of India (GoI) under the Small Development Project (SDP). Despite a 9-month contract period (starting April 10, 2025), the contractor completed the 4.7 km GSB work ahead of schedule, showcasing excellent project execution without compromising quality. The work scope includes (a) Construction of Plum L-drain, (b) Installation of boulder cross-drainage structures, and (c) Laying of GSB over the full road length.

#### 2. Dryland Irrigation and Drinking Water at Ngarpongtang under Thangrong Gewog





The Dry-land Irrigation Project, implemented under the Small Development Project (SDP) framework, aimed to enhance agricultural productivity and water access for farming households in dry-land regions. A total of 115 households benefited from the project through improved irrigation infrastructure. Materials



were procured and managed by the Geog Administration, while the beneficiary households contributed labor, ensuring strong local ownership and cost-effectiveness. It was a successful example of participatory rural development. By combining government resource allocation with community labor, the project has not only improved irrigation access but also empowered local communities to take charge of their development needs.

## Challenges

During the reporting year, the Dzongkhag encountered several challenges that affected the smooth delivery of planned programs and services. Some of the challenges are as mentioned below:

- a) Mid-year resignation of Teachers: Despite several interventions and sensitization, the resignation of teachers in the middle of the academic session disrupted the continuity of teaching and learning, necessitating urgent recruitment and adjustments in school timetables;
- b) The participation of contractors in the blacktopping (BT) works remained low, resulting in delays in the award of work under the SDP phase 1;
- Restrictions in fund allocation limited the implementation of the Dzongkhag's planned activities, such as sensitization and awareness campaigns on disaster preparedness, health, culture, and other related areas;
- d) Delay in receiving the angle posts and other accessories for the chain link fencing significantly affected the work progress in two Gewogs;
- e) Implementing deposit works toward the end of the financial year was challenging, as most were assigned unexpectedly and without prior consultation; AND
- f) The absence of support from the Ministry for the Dzongkhag's proposal to acquire a waste compactor vehicle and a water tanker has constrained efforts to address effective waste management, water shortage, and improve disaster preparedness.
